GIVING TUESDAY IS NOV. 30

On every Tuesday after Thanksgiving, the United States celebrates “Giving Tuesday.” This year, the international day of giving is scheduled for Tuesday, Nov. 30.

As a non-profit organization, Ebenezer Medical Outreach is seeking donations of any kind to help us continue offering free and affordable comprehensive healthcare to our 8 counties. To provide an extra incentive for donations made to us, Ebenezer Medical Outreach has been awarded NIP, Neighborhood Investment Program, credits.

The NIP credits are available on a first come, first serve basis. These credits allot for any donation over \$500 to be matched at a 50% level and applied to a donor's West Virginia state taxes. They are dollar for dollar credit. If a donor lives outside of West Virginia, a NIP credit can be applied to their Federal taxes.

Giving through the holidays, as well as all year long, helps us to provide important medical services like dental, medical, and orthopedic care to patients who are uninsured or under-insured. Donations allow us to provide continuing healthcare outreach to patients in Cabell, Lincoln, Putnam, Mason, and Wayne counties in West Virginia, Boyd and Greenup counties in Kentucky, and Lawrence County, OH.
